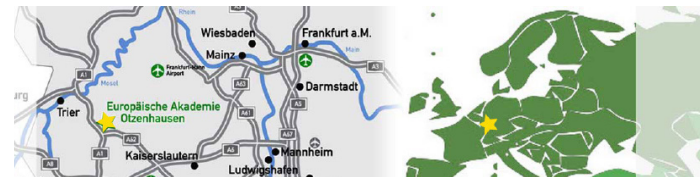

The European Academy and the Young European Federalists organize a seminar with young multipliers from Germany, France and the Western Balkans in Germany. The focus of the meeting is on methodological approaches and thematic exchange on the topic of the culture of remembrance and the regional and European integration. The participants will have the possibility to discuss the topic with different experts and develop and share their own methodology, which they will then apply in their own organizations.

Conditions of participation and eligibility criteria:

- Socio-politically involved organizations (NGOs / civil society)
- Organizations from Germany, France and the Western Balkans
- Long-term participation in the project
- Good command of English (B2 CEFR) (working language is English)
- Travel costs can be partially reimbursed
- The closing date for applications is August 20, 2018

The Project

Background

The project „Making Europe work“ brings together young motivated Europeans and their organizations from the Western Balkans, France and Germany and focuses on ways to enhance civil society cooperation in and between these regions.

Which challenges do politics and societies face in the light of recent developments in Europe? What are the options for future European cooperation between the EU Member States and non-EU countries? What is the role of the young generation and what are its possibilities for action in these fields? The Franco-German motor and the Western Balkans, a European region of crisis and opportunity, are of central importance in this context.

Project objectives and period

Civil society organizations as disseminators of progressive ideas play a key role in this respect.

The project therefore aims to bring together organizations from the regions mentioned above, who are committed to active citizenship.

The goal is to encourage them and to develop their skills further, to promote the coordination of existing initiatives and to launch the implementation of joint transnational projects. The main objectives are empowerment, networking and coordination as well as project development.

The project started in 2016 and will run until 2019.

Events

The organizations that are part of this project should take part in the following events.

Running until late 2019, the project will consist of two further face-to-face encounters.

Another seminar will take place at the Europäische Akademie Otzenhausen in spring 2019 and there will be a final conference in Tirana in September 2019.

In between the face-to-face meetings, participants meet up and exchange in online meetings. This provides an opportunity to stay in touch and discuss current developments and challenges as well as the upcoming meetings.

We invite experts to join the online discussions and provide input on the topic at hand.

The seminar is embedded in a long-term project. Therefore we are searching for organizations which will participate in the remainder of the project until late 2019. The organization should be able and willing to send a participant to all upcoming events.
